## Creating an Unforgettable Memorial Service

October 15th is Infant and Pregnancy Loss Awareness Day, October is Infant and Pregnancy Loss Awareness Month... plan a remembrance ceremony for all the babies who died this year.

### First Steps:

- Reserve a medium sized chapel for the event.
- Send invitations to everyone on your email list, including your installation's top brass and the FRG channels.
- Contact your post newspaper to inform them of the event. (Visit [www.DynastyBookPublishers.com](http://www.DynastyBookPublishers.com) to download free "cookie cutter" templates.)
- Ensure the chapel has candle votives on hand for a candle lighting service.
- Provide an inexpensive keepsake for those in attendance.
- Get volunteers to greet, escort attendees to their seat, and more.

### Planning the Program:

- Invite a guest speaker to share words of hope and encouragement.
- Invite a talented soloist or group to sing.
- Allow room on the program for parents an opportunity to share a few words in remembrance of their angel.
- Plan then print your programs.

### Executing the Program:

- Set the mood. Keep lighting dim and music soft.
- After the service, turn up the lights and put on more festive music.
- Don't forget to encourage everyone to sign the guest book with full name and email address, so you can invite them again next year.

## Are the resources you offer bereaved parents sufficient?

### Review the checklist below to see if you measure up . . .

- Do you have packets filled with customized information for their unique circumstance, including a pamphlet about miscarriage or stillbirth, grief support group info, numbers to MilitaryOne Source and other on post resources?
- Do you have trained bereavement counselors tending to the patient?
- Do you have a certificate of birth or other type of certificate to present the bereaved?
- Do you have a digital camera to take pictures of the deceased baby?
- Do you offer personal stories and self-help literature for patients?
- Do you have an ink pad and special paper for tiny hand and foot prints?
- Do you offer memorial boxes, keepsakes, quilt squares or other mementos?
- Have you delegated a person to follow up with patients after discharge?

Effective bereavement programs must have: bereavement counselors available at the time of delivery/miscarriage, monthly grief support meetings, follow up care and quality resources to take home and read. Without all of these key components your program suffers, and so do your patients.

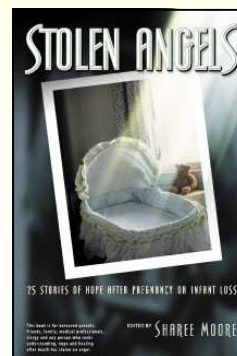
